Candidates must complete the application in its entirety. Candidates should list the Article 4 pension fund they participate in for their response to Participating Pension Fund.

Candidate Eligibility

A candidate for a Beneficiary Trustee position shall be a beneficiary in continuing service as a beneficiary from the date the candidate application is submitted through the election date of December 1st. A candidate for Beneficiary Trustee shall be nominated by a petition signed by no fewer than 100 individuals who, as of the date of signing, were beneficiaries.

Definition

“Beneficiary” means an Annuitant, Deferred Pensioner, or a Disabled Pensioner.

“Annuitant” means a retired firefighter receiving a retirement pension from a participating pension fund.

“Deferred Pensioner” means a firefighter who has retired having accumulated enough creditable service to qualify for a pension under Article 4 of the Pension Code but who has not attained the required age for commencement of the pension.

“Disabled Pensioner” means a firefighter receiving a disability pension from a participating pension fund.

Beneficiary Trustee Positions

A) One Beneficiary Trustee shall be elected to serve a 2-year term.
